







3.1 Standard Lighting Techniques: Key Light


Key light: principal source of illumination (normally a directional spot).






3.2 Standard Lighting Techniques: Back Light


Back light: rims top and separates subject from background (normally a directional spot).







#### 3.3 Standard Lighting Techniques: Fill Light

Fill light: controls falloff (normally a floodlight).














# .4 Expanded Lighting echniques: Side Light

## 3.5 Expanded Lighting Techniques: Kicker Light


Kicker: directional spot from the back, off to one side, usually from below.

# 3.6 Expanded Lighting Techniques: Background, or Set, Light


Background light: background or set illumination (often by spots).



**4.69** A bit of back light is added to separate the actors slightly from the background.



**4.70** A window pattern (supposedly coming from the moon or a street light) is used to show the back wall slightly. (Series of photos by Roger Conrad)


